

Become a Glen Lake Guardian

Pledge for Landscapers and Lawn Maintenance Companies

If you do business within the Glen Lake-Crystal River Watershed, your support is needed to protect and preserve this beautiful area. By taking the Guardian Pledge, you and your business agree to adopt the following best practices to guide the services you provide.

My business and I pledge to:

- Encourage clients to 1) preserve or restore the natural greenbelt and shoreline areas to enhance filtration and control runoff, while accommodating reasonable desires for sight corridors and usable yards and shorelines 2) use materials that will limit runoff and the need for chemicals and fertilizers 3) employ energy-absorbing shoreline structures where required 4) never blow leaves or grass clippings in the water
- Avoid, where possible, designs or activities that could be detrimental to the water or to natural shorelines and greenbelts.
- Comply with all state and local regulations and ordinances that protect the watershed — including greenbelts, shorelines, wetlands, drainage and inspection requirements. For example, state law prohibits applying phosphorus-containing fertilizer within 5-15 feet of the water's edge.
- Train and supervise your employees adequately on the requirements for this pledge.
- Provide to all clients and prospects a copy of the Glen Lake Association's "Landscaping and Lawn Care" brochure.
